# RESIDENTIAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES

### ICF ID GROUP HOMES

- Six (6) bed group homes funded by Medicaid
- Level of Need/Care (LON/C) established by the Alamo Local Authority (ALA)
- Ninety-four (94) group homes in San Antonio

### APARTMENT PROGRAMS

### Mission Road Ministries (MRM)

- Three (3) apartment complexes in different areas of San Antonio
- Must have a developmental disability
- Reduced rent based on income
- Apartment manager at each property who provides support services

### Reaching Maximum Independence (RMI)

- Three (3) apartment locations
- Must have a developmental disability
- No rental subsidy/assistance
- Monthly fee for support services

## **HCS and ICF/ID Group Homes**

### What is a group home?

A group home is a living environment where six or fewer individuals live. The facility provides 24-hour a day residential and habilitative services for consumers with mental retardation or dual diagnosis. Prior to admission, the consumer's current level of care will need to be determined based on medical, social and psychological evaluations. Individuals receive more extensive training in hygiene, meal preparation, money management and behavior management. All participants must be involved in a day program whether that is a sheltered workshop, day habilitation program or community employment.

### How does an individual apply for a group home?

Individuals must have a diagnosis of Intellectual Disability (IQ of 70 or below) or a related condition and have Medicaid.

### What is Supervised Apartment Living?

A supervised Apartment Living program is an apartment program that specializes in providing minimal assistance to individuals in household management and community mobility. Participating individuals must be independent in self-care, self-medication and self-evacuation. Participants can be single or married and must be actively involved in competitive employment, sheltered employment, vocational training or a day activity program.


