# **RESIDENTIAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES**

## **ICF ID GROUP HOMES**

- Six (6) bed group homes funded by Medicaid
- Level of Need/Care (LON/C) established by the Alamo Local Authority (ALA)
- Ninety-four (94) group homes in San Antonio

## **APARTMENT PROGRAMS**

### **Mission Road Ministries (MRM)**

- Three (3) apartment complexes in different areas of San Antonio
- Must have a developmental disability
- Reduced rent based on income
- Apartment manager at each property who provides support services

### **Reaching Maximum Independence (RMI)**

- Three (3) apartment locations
- Must have a developmental disability
- No rental subsidy/assistance
- Monthly fee for support services





# Respite Care

Mission Road Ministries offers overnight care for families caring for children with intellectual developmental disabilities (IDD). Respite Care is available to families living in Bexar County who wish to partner with trained professionals in the provision of dependable extended care for their child with IDD.

Respite Care is a comforting option for families traveling on vacation, conferences, or business travel that might present challenging environments for children with special needs.

Many families welcome regularly scheduled respite weekends allowing families frequent opportunities to share uninterrupted time with siblings and extended family.

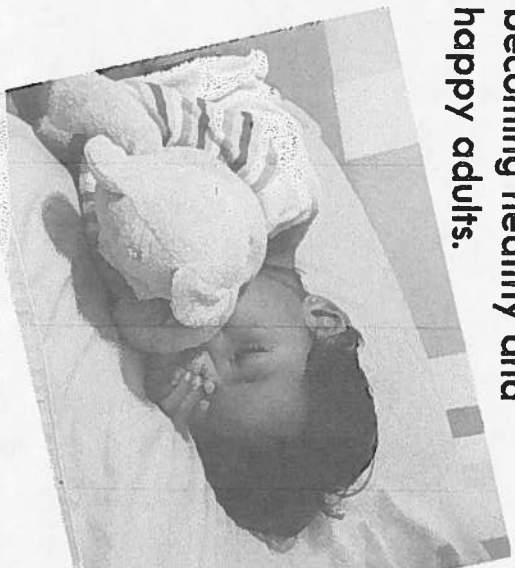

Mission Road Ministries, a family of agencies, is a community-based, church sponsored organization with a Call from God to minister to persons with intellectual and other developmental disabilities by challenging them to achieve their full potential for independence, productivity and inclusion in the community.

Children participating in our **Respite Care** program spend the night with new friends in one of our 5 campus cottages with 24-hour **AWAKE** care.

Children with IDD require a great deal of structure and predictability to move forward becoming healthy and happy adults.



Meals & Medication

Children eat each meal as a family in our cottages, starting each meal by saying grace. A nutritious breakfast, lunch and dinner and frequent snacks are made daily. 24-hour professional nursing care is provided daily in our campus clinic by nurses highly experienced in caring for children with IDD. All medication is administered with exacting care.

Tuition

Respite Care is billed by the day for each 24-hour of care. Exact daily fees are determined individually for each child based upon his/her level of need. Exact pricing is determined at the time of assessment.
